Tournament – John Kraft

 - 14 WASA teams, 9 GSA teams, and a handful of Inner City teams all played for free
- o Money:
 - 10% of revenue from concession stand was donated
 - \$1416.00 sent to orphanage in Africa
 - 6 boxes of soccer equipment was also sent
 - Shelly Reid was paid as emergency aid but donated her fee to help ship equipment to Africa.
 - The tournament basically broke even
