Referee Instructions

When you arrive at Muhl Park to referee your games:

- 1. Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to game time.
- 2. Go to appropriate field. Meet up with other referee and decide how you are working the field. For example, you might decide on a referee on each side.
- 3. Complete Referee Payment Form with other referee and both coaches
- 4. Check the goals to make sure that they are secured complete Goal Inspection Report.
- 5. Check players in about 5 minutes before game time. Have each referee check in a team.
- 6. Check the goalie shirts. Make sure that they are a different color than all the other players.
- 7. Get game ball from home team
- 8. Let each coach know that you are ready to start the game.
- 9. Move to the center of the field and place the ball to start the game.
- 10. Count players on the field. Make sure there are equal players on both sides (4 field players and 1 goal keeper).
- 11. Start your watch to begin timing the period (both refs should do this for backup)
- 12. Blow whistle to start game.
- 13. For any game day issues please see In-house Director, U7/U8 commissioners and/or a member of the ref/coaching team that is on the premise.

Reminders to Referees:

- ✓ **Blow your whistle loud.** Coaches and Players like to hear it.
- ✓ Keep control of the game. Watch for pushing and grabbing. Warn players if they continue.
- ✓ **Instruct players.** Some players have never played or just forgot how to play. Remind them how to do a throw-in. When the ball goes out, say whose ball it is and point them in the right direction.
- ✓ **Protect the Goalie.** If the goalie is reaching for the ball and a player is still kicking, blow your whistle. The kids don't realize they could hurt the goalie.
- ✓ **Remember it is for fun.** Let the players enjoy the game.
